Notes

1. The cost of a dog licence is £16.00.
2. The cost of a licence(s) for dog(s) which has been neutered/spayed is £8.00. A certificate identifying the dog(s) stating that it/they have been neutered and signed by a Veterinary Surgeon must be produced to support your claim.
3. The cost of a licence for a dog(s) kept by a person aged over 60 years is £8.00. You must produce either your pension book, birth certificate or current passport.
4. No duty shall be charged for:
 - a. dog(s) under the age of 6 months, unless its keeper is a person other than the person whom it was kept immediately after its birth.
 - b. dog(s) kept and used solely by a blind person for his/her guidance.
 - c. dog(s) kept and used solely for law enforcement purposes or search and rescue purposes by such authorities as may be prescribed;
 - c,a dog(s) kept and used solely for (i) sporting purposes; or (ii) catching or destroying vermin; (iii) driving or tending cattle or sheep.
 - d. dog(s) brought to and remaining in the Island for a period of not more than 28 days in any one year.
5. All current dog licences expire on the 31st March. Licences for the coming year commence 1st April may be renewed/taken out now.
6. Under the Schedule to the Wild Animals (Restriction on Importation, etc.) Act 1980, no person shall own the type of dogs known commonly as Pit Bull Terrier or Japanese Tosa (or Tosa).
